An intensive investigation into the "deer-hunt" death of Lester Newman, 59-year-old Eugene hunter, was being carried on at the scene of the shooting Wednesday by state police

officers under the direction of Sergeant Lowell Hirtzel and Deputy Coroner Harold Poole. Brought, to state police headquarters here Tuesday following first report of the shooting, three companion huntsmen of Newman were questioned by District Attorney L. L. Ray and state officers Tuesday night. Investigation in the Fall creek woods where Newman met his death was launched early Wednesday morning.

Varney Baker, Clarence Davis and Walter Easton, who were on the hunting trip with Newman, told officers the shot which killed Newman had not come from one of their guns because they were not shooting at the time. They declared they found Newman dead shortly after a rifle report nearby had been heard.

State police officers had not returned to Eugene later Wednesday afternoon and could not be reached for a statement concerning investigation developments.
