Died in this city yesterday at the home of Mrs. Martha Baker. James, aged 73 years. He was a pioneer resident of this county and a highly respected person. He was the brother of E.D. Baker, the only surviving member of the immediate family in this section.

He was born in Cumberland county, Kentucky, Dec. 2, 1825; migrated to Illinois in 1840, where he resided for thirteen years. while there he married Miss Eliza Hudson, May 1, 1851, and in 1853 crossed the plains to Oregon. He purchased the tract of land where he died from James Sidney on arriving here and made it his continuous home until death. In July 1859, his wife died leaving him four children, two sons and two daughters. In 1861 he married Mrs. Mary Bushell, the fruits of which marriage were eight sons and two daughters, four of whom preceded him.

The funeral will take place from the family residence Tuesday forenoon, July 18, at 10 o'clock.

While there he married Miss Eliza Hudson, May 1, 1851, and in 1853 crossed the plains to Oregon. He purchased the tract of land, where he died, from James Sidney on arriving here and made it his continuous home until death. In July 1859, his wife died leaving him four children, two sons and two daughters.
